Students completed at least two years of study at their Philadelphia Career and Technical Education High Schools before they submitted applications to SEPTA through the established process on-line. Students who met the academic criteria were recommended by their teachers and then endorsed by Philadelphia Academies before they were interviewed by SEPTA. Students completed the 8 week program from June 30 through August 22, 2014.

Students worked 8-hour days, 5 days per week, from 6 a.m. to 3 p.m. Students were not allowed to be absent or late more than 3 times to complete the program. Students received on the job training for public transit vehicle maintenance. A TWU mentor was assigned for each student as they worked beside mechanics on Bus and Rail Vehicles. Each student was encouraged to keep a journal of their experiences.
